Water service connection work from Ross Terrace to Elm Avenue

Location: Ross Terrace to Elm Avenue at Sir Francis Drake Boulevard


Starting: Monday Night, April 5th, 2021 | 7:00 p.m. – 4:00 a.m.

Duration: 2 weeks – Monday Night through Saturday Morning

Starting on Monday night, April 5th, the Upgrade the Drake contractor will be working on water service connections between Ross Terrace and Elm Avenue along Sir Francis Drake Boulevard. The work will last approximately two weeks, and will take place at night from 7:00 p.m. – 4:00 a.m. to minimize significant traffic impacts. There will be one-lane, alternating two-way traffic controls in place. Eastbound motorists may use Laurel Grove Avenue as a detour. Other motorists may use Lagunitas Road/Poplar Avenue/Kent Avenue/College Avenue as an alternate route. Traffic delays can be expected in both directions through the work zone.

Please watch for flaggers, who will be controlling traffic, and make sure to slow down through the construction area. The construction team thanks you for your patience.

The red bar below illustrates where the night work is taking place. The green line indicates the detour for eastbound traffic, and the orange line indicates the alternate route.
